Police Report:

Marshal Patterson has scheduled 2 officers on at a time for the 3 day celebration and 9 officers on Saturday. She has contacted the County for extra patrol if officers are free.

The Department is sponsoring "Hit the Car" and "Radar Games" with donations going to Baron and the Drug Interdiction programs.

The Dept. has been approved to receive \$2500 towards an all terrain vehicle from Hendricks Power. The Dept. has applied for a grant through CSX, because this is about one-third the money needed to buy an ATV. This would be used for patrol of wooded areas, railroad tracks and used by the Fire Dept. for any emergencies. The Dept. will apply for an equipment grant in August.

The speed trailer has been requested to be moved onto Kensington Ct. to monitor speeding.

Officer Maples has not been able to work with Sgt. Stumm on the Drug Interdiction runs on I70 due to commitments with the Brownsburg Police Dept.

Marshal Patterson would like to have the consent from the Council to appoint to the Pittsboro Reserves two officers from the Plainfield Police Dept. These officers, Brian Stewart and Jarrod McKee would be assigned with Sgt Stumm 24 hours a month only on Drug Interdiction runs.

S. Smith made a motion to appoint Brian Stewart and Jarrod McKee as Reserve Officers assigned to Drug Interdiction with Sgt. Stumm. J. Hart seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried.

Marshal Patterson announced her appointment to the Hendricks County Communications Operations Board.
