Mr. Burke called the meeting to order for the scheduled Park Board meeting. He then asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Comments from the Public:

A full discussion from the representatives of the Tri-West Little League revealed a shortage of baseball diamonds with increasing numbers of players. The interest of the grounds for baseball diamonds in our Scamahorn Park would like to be considered for this expansion needed for their league play.

This did entertain the discussion to use funds from the Park Impact fees to expand these baseball fields in our parks to provide more play for children in the community.

The league could provide volunteers for the building of some parts of the diamond or diamonds and some concessions and dugout facilities.

The league representatives and the Park Board will meet in the Scamahorn Park on Monday September 12th at 6:00pm to oversee the grounds for diamond measurements and have some building costs to evaluate as a workable project.

A discussion followed to re-establish the Park Impact fee due to some building growth that continues in our community.

Mr. Hart ask for a motion to establish a new Ordinance to take effect and continue for the Park Impact fee.

William Majeske made a motion to establish a new Ordinance for the Park Impact Fee. Doug Joiner seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. This new Ordinance will be on the agenda at the Town Council meeting September 20th 2011.

Shelby Smith made a motion for the Town Council President to appoint the committee to prepare the statue for the Park Impact fee. William Majeske seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried.

Janet Walker made a motion for the meeting to adjourn. Don Burke seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. The meeting was adjourned.
