PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE & MOMENT OF SILENCE:

7:00 p.m. – President John Hart brought the Council meeting to order by establishing a quorum. All five (5) members are present. He asked the Council, staff and audience to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and to follow with a Moment of Silence.

REAPPOINT MEMBERS OF REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

President John Hart has signed the Certificate of Appointments for Joyce Compton, Larry Compton, Dan Devlin, Jim Hill and Larry Woods to serve on the Redevelopment Commission.

PUBLIC HEARING - PHASE 2 WATER IMPROVEMENTS

President John Hart opened the Public Hearing and turned the floor over to Eric Wathen from RQAW. Eric Wathen, RQAW, read the following:

"The Town of Pittsboro has submitted an application for a Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Loan for improvements to the Town's drinking water system. Phase 2 of the project involves the construction of a new water treatment plant, production wells, raw water mains, and a new finished water transmission main. This will eliminate the need for the Town to rely on Citizens Energy Group for its water supply. The Preliminary Engineering Report for Phase 2 of the project is available for public viewing at the Pittsboro Town Hall during normal business hours through Tuesday, November 14. Written comments will be accepted through the 14th.

John Hart asked for a motion to close the Public Hearing. Bill Majeske made to close the Public Hearing, Doug Joiner seconded. All ayes, motion carries.

OTHER BUSINESS

Opened bids last week. There were 6 bidders and the lowest bid was Subservice of Indiana at \$777,000.00. John Hart is asking for Jason Love to authorize his signature on the Notice of Award letter. Shelby Smith made a motion, Bill Majeske seconded. All ayes, motion carries.

Eric Wathen, HC Council Member (not RQAW), there is a company wanting to locate a poultry feed mill in our area. It's a \$300 million operation adding 1600 jobs on 300 acres. Interested but have more questions.

Jason Love just received a report from London Witte with new numbers for the water plant. Increase in water rate would be significant in order to move forward with the SRF. Go ahead with Phase 1 and shelf Phase 2. Talk to Brownsburg about selling water to them. The water rates have to cover the debt ratio.
