NEW BUSINESS

ARPA Fund Expenditures – Jarod Baker turned to Jason Love to go over his plans for the use of the funds (see attached list). IDEM is requiring a generator at the new water plant. We need to include number 1, 2 & 3 in an ordinance and hold number 4 until later. Jason can go ahead with exploring of well study since it is under his spending limit. 




