## NEW HOSE METER INFORMATION

According to ordinance 2022-10, the Town of Pittsboro has agreed to expand the hose meter billing credits an additional month, the new schedule is as followed:

- May 18 through June 17
- June 18 through July 17
- July 18 through August 17
- August 18 through September 17
- September 18 through October 17 (NEW)

This ordinance also requires an annual verification of hose meter readings before cards are distributed for 2023 and moving forward.

There are two ways to present your readings:

- Visit Town Hall (80 N Meridian Street) before May 5th during business hours. Please bring your meter physically with you to have it validated and cards will be presented to you at that time.

Photo of your meter number (located on the lid)  
Photo of your current meter reading (open lid and take photo)

Cards will not be distributed until validation is completed via one of the two options noted above.

Please note that Option 2 (email) is only for annual validation, you are still required to mail or deliver in person your cards monthly and will not be accepted via email.

## TRASH COLLECTION UPDATE

The Town of Pittsboro is taking over weekly trash pickup effective May 15.

In this change, some will have their weekly trash services moved from Wednesdays. Included is a map that will notify you of your new day of the week trash will be picked

up for your residence. If there is a holiday at the beginning of a week (Monday) all routes will move forward one day for that week of service. This will be the holiday schedule.

Please ensure your trash is either bagged, or bagged in a trash bin and at the curb no

later than 6:00 am of your scheduled day.

If you have a Waste Management (WM) recycling agreement, that will remain active as that is a service you have directly with WM and the Town of Pittsboro is not involved.
